Welcome to the latest edition of *Rotary HealthRays Update*, an electronic newsletter that provides you with news and developments from the <u>Rotary HealthRays</u> initiative - Rotary District 6440's effort to bring digital x-ray technology to needy populations in Guatemala -- and eventually, around the world.



We have great news to share in this edition of *Update*, including new details about our fundraising efforts. As of today we have received more than \$500,000 in funding commitments, with 40 clubs and 14 districts participating so far!

In addition to the three digital x-ray machines we have already installed, we now have secured funding for five more machines -- bringing our total to eight!

We estimate that each digital x-ray machine we install can serve between 50,000 and 100,000 Guatemalans in need. Our efforts are already impacting between 150,000 and 300,000 Guatemalans, who previously had no access to this important health care technology.

# Turmoil in Guatemala and its Impact on HealthRays

If you follow the news, you may be familiar with the political situation in Guatemala, where major political upheavals in recent months have impacted the government.

Guatemala's president recently resigned amid political pressure, and other senior government officials have also been forced out of office.



We are happy to report that the problems in Guatemala have not caused issues with the operation of our digital x-ray clinics at all. They continue to function as originally planned.

But during this period of turmoil, some governmental regulatory processes have been affected. One example is the issuance of customs-duty exemptions for not-for-profit organizations, which were suspended temporarily.

Because our HealthRays project relies on customs-duty exemptions, progress on upcoming installations has been delayed until the exemptions are restored.

In a special election on Oct. 26, Guatemalans chose Jimmy Morales as their new president. With his election, we expect that pending questions such as status of the customs-duty exemption will be resolved and we can resume with our installation schedule. We will keep you posted!

### **Rotary Districts Continue to Sign On with HealthRays!**

Rotary districts 5950 (Minnesota) and 7360 (Maryland, Pennsylvania and West Virginia) recently became the latest Rotary districts to join our HealthRays initiative, pledging \$10,000 each.

2017-18 District Governor Nominees in Rotary Zones 28 and 29 have organized a "class project" in hopes of garnering support from additional districts for our project.

We reported in our last *Update* on the generosity of several districts in Taiwan that also joined our effort. Awareness of HealthRays is growing throughout the Rotary world and we are encouraged by it!

We thank Rotarians in Minnesota, Maryland, Pennsylvania and West Virginia for their contributions!

# New HealthRays organizational team formed in Guatemala

With our project growing and funding now in place for a total of eight digital x-ray clinics, HealthRays has added an organizational team to help with logistics in Guatemala. Rotary International Director-Elect **Jorge Aufranc** and Rotarian **Jurg Egli** will co-chair a new group to help oversee the implementation process locally as digital x-ray machines are installed. Also assisting with several of the clinic installations are Rotarians from the **Rotary Club of Guatemala Asuncion** and the **Rotary Club of Guatemala Sur**.

We thank Jorge, Jurg and the Rotarians from Guatemala Asuncion and Guatemala Sur for taking on this important role at a time when HealthRays is moving into a significant new phase of development.

### Rotary HealthRays in brief

As many as four billion people around the globe - basically two-thirds of the entire population -- have little or no access to simple x-ray technology, which is taken for granted as a basic health tool in most industrialized nations.

Rotarians in Rotary International District 6440 - near Chicago, Illinois -- have launched an effort to address this problem, with a new cross-sector model for action that we have introduced in Guatemala and hope to replicate eventually in countries around the world. Working with the Guatemalan government and the PAHO, our primary goal is to install 29 digital x-ray units in underserved areas throughout Guatemala.

Eventually, our project will impact more than one and a half million people in that country, where health care outcomes are among the worst in Central America.
